Closed Sales of Single Family Homes Up in 4 of 5 MLSListings Counties

October 2018 Data for MLSListings Counties (from North to South):

In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,600,000 and sold in 13 days for 107% of the list price based on 427 sales in October 2018.

- Inventory dipped -5% from September, but climbed 51% from October 2017 with 643 homes available, compared to 427 homes last year.
- Average days on market (DOM) dropped -4 days from 24 to 20 or -17%; median DOM was unchanged from the month before at 13 days.
- Number of new listings for the month of October decreased -22% over September but rose 18% from October of last year.
- Closed sales jumped 37% from September from 312 to 427, and up 9% from October 2017.

In Santa Clara County, the median Single Family home cost \$1,290,000 and sold in 14 days for 102% of the list price based on 826 sales in October 2018.

- Inventory was up 2% from September, and up 92% from October 2017 with 1,615 homes available, compared to 843 homes last year.
- Average days on market (DOM) dropped -1 days from 28 to 27 or -4%; median DOM dropped -2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October decreased -12% over September but rose 19% from October of last year.
- Closed sales went up 12% from September from 738 to 826, but down -7% from October 2017.

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$866,500 and sold in 21 days for 99% of the list price based on 178 sales in October 2018.

- Inventory dipped -5% from September, but gained 7% from October 2017 with 537 homes available, compared to 503 homes last year.
- Average days on market (DOM) dropped -9 days from 54 to 45 or -17%; median DOM rose 2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October remained flat with September but rose 6% from October of last year.
- Closed sales gained 28% from September from 139 to 178 but down -5% from October 2017.



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In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$610,000 and sold in 27 days for 99% of the list price based on 207 sales in October 2018.

- Inventory was down -2% from September, and down -5% from October 2017 with 861 homes available, compared to 911 homes last year.
- Average days on market (DOM) lost -2 days from 55 to 53 or -4%; median DOM gained 8 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October increased 7% over September, but down -2% from October of last year.
- Closed sales dipped -8% from September from 226 to 207, and down -14% from October 2017.

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$599,000 and sold in 22 days for 100% of the list price based on 45 sales in October 2018.

- Inventory was down -1% from September, and down -6% from October 2017 with 147 homes available, compared to 157 homes last year.
- Average days on market (DOM) lost -2 days from 39 to 37 or -5%; median DOM dropped -2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October slid -21% over September, and down -19% from October of last year.
- Closed sales rose 18% from September from 38 to 45, but down -12% from October 2017.
