

MLSListings County Summaries Common Interest Homes June 2022

In **San Mateo County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$940,000 and sold in 10 days for 103% of the list price based on 128 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 240 up 4% from May and up 8% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) remained at 18 days or 0% change; median DOM increased 1 day from May.
- Number of new listings for the month of June were down -10% over May, and down -9% from June of last year
- Closed sales were down -17% from May from 154 to 128, closed sales were also down -33% from June 2021

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$965,000 and sold in 9 days for 105% of the list price based on 390 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 575 up 13% from May and down -3% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 2 days from 11 to 13 or up 18%; median DOM increased 2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -8% compared to May, and down -21% from June of last year
- Closed sales down -20% from May from 486 to 390, closed sales were also down -39% from June 2021

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$800,000 and sold in 9 days for 102% of the list price based on 35 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 67 up 16% from May and up 24% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 5 days from 7 to 12 or up 71%; median DOM increased 3 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June were down -27% over May, down -24% from June of last year
- Closed sales were up 25% from May from 28 to 35, closed sales were down -20% from June 2021

In **Monterey County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$550,000 and sold in 10 days for 102% of the list price based on 29 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 36 up 20% from May but down -42% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 3 days from 14 to 17 or up 21%; median DOM was unchanged at 10 days.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was up 15% over May, and down -31 from June of last year
- Closed sales were up 7% from May from 27 to 29, Closed sales were down -42% from June 2021





In **San Benito County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$659,000 and sold in 2 days for 97% of the list price based on 5 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 7 up 17% from May 2022 and up 600% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 2 days from 12 to 14 or up 17%; median DOM dropped 10 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was up 100% over May, and up 100% from June of last year
- Closed sales were up 150% from May from 2 to 5, closed sales were the same as June 2021
