In **San Mateo County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$921,750 and sold in 27 days for 100% of the list price based on 100 sales in October 2022

- Inventory was 218 up -13% from September and down -12% from October 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -4 days from 37 to 33 or down -11%; median DOM increased 3 days from September.
- Number of new listings for the month of October were down -42% over September, and down -52% from October of last year
- Closed sales were up 1% from September from 99 to 100, closed sales were down -40% from October 2021

In Santa Clara County, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$891,500 and sold in 16 days for 100% of the list price based on 248 sales in October 2022

- Inventory was 451 down -3% from September and up 2% from October 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -1 day from 28 to 27 or down -4%; median DOM decreased -4 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October was down -14% compared to September, and down -36% from October of last year
- Closed sales were down -30% from September from 355 to 248, closed sales were also down -49% from October 2021

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$822,500 and sold in 22 days for 99% of the list price based on 22 sales in October 2022

- Inventory was 50 down -9% from September but up 43% from October 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 20 days from 20 to 40 or up 100%; median DOM increased 8 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October were up 9% over September, down
 -19% from October of last year
- Closed sales were down -45% from September from 40 to 22, closed sales were down -49% from October 2021

In **Monterey County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$587,000 and sold in 14 days for 101% of the list price based on 22 sales in October 2022

- Inventory was 51 up 9% from September and up 9% from October 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -5 days from 27 to 22 or down -19%; median DOM increased 2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October was down -19% over September, and down -36% from October of last year
- Closed sales decreased -21% from September from 28 to 22, and were down -48% from October 2021

In San Benito County, there were no Residential - Common Interest sales in October 2022.
