

MLSListings County Summaries Single Family Homes June 2022

In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$2,050,000 and sold in 9 days for 109% of the list price based on 374 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 615 up 27% from May 2022 and up 19% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) remained at 14 days or 0%; median DOM gained 1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was up 5% over May, down -9% from June of last year
- Closed sales dropped -20% from May from 470 to 374, Closed sales down -34% from June 2021

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,805,000 and sold in 9 days for 106% of the list price based on 920 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 1317 up 14% from May 2022 and up 47% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) gained 3 days from 11 to 14 or 27%; median DOM increased 1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -11% over May, and down -14% from June of last year
- Closed sales were down -5% from May from 965 to 920, Closed sales down -31% from June 2021

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,325,000 and sold in 11 days for 104% of the list price based on 143 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 304 up 4% from May 2022 and down -3% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 5 days from 13 to 18 or down -38%; median DOM gained 2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -19% over May, down -15% from June of last year
- Closed sales were down -9% from May from 158 to 143, Closed sales down -35% from June 2021

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$857,000 and sold in 12 days for 100% of the list price based on 212 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 477 up 7% from May 2022 and up 1% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 10 days from 17 to 27 or up 59%; median DOM gained 3 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -17% over May, and down -18% from June of last year
- Closed sales were up 5% from May from 201 to 212, Closed sales down -21% from June 2021





In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$859,500 and sold in 17 days for 99% of the list price based on 42 sales in June 2022

- Inventory was 122 up 3% from May 2022 and up 7% from June 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 1 day from 20 to 21 or up 5%; median DOM increased 6 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -21% over May, and down -43% from June of last year
- Closed sales were down -26% from May from 57 to 42, Closed sales down -44% from June 2021
