- Number of new listings for the month of September was down -2% over August, and down -27% from September of last year
- Closed sales were up 3% from August from 797 to 818, Closed sales down -26% from September 2021

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,199,500 and sold in 18 days for 100% of the list price based on 132 sales in September 2022

- Inventory was 286 up 1% from August 2022 and up 7% from September 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 2 days from 29 to 31 days; median DOM was unchanged from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of September was down -10% from August, down -15% from September of last year
- Closed sales were down -10% from August from 146 to 132, Closed sales down -29% from September 2021

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$822,500 and sold in 17 days for 99% of the list price based on 194 sales in September 2022

- Inventory was 466 down -9% from August 2022 but up 1% from September 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) was unchanged at 30 days; median DOM decreased -2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of September was down -22% over August, and down -21% from September of last year
- Closed sales were up 8% from August from 180 to 194, Closed sales were down -18% from September 2021

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$750,000 and sold in 34 days for 99% of the list price based on 45 sales in September 2022

- Inventory was 151 down -2% from August 2022 and up 24% from September 2021
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -36 days from 71 to 35 or down -51%; median DOM increased 2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of September was down -8% over August, and down -14% from September of last year
- Closed sales were up 73% from August from 26 to 45, Closed sales down -29% from September 2021
