



MLSListings County Summaries Single Family Homes | April 2023

In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,850,000 and sold in 11 days for 103% of the list price based on 225 sales in April 2023

- Inventory was 390 up 16% from March and up 5% from April 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) moved down -5 days from 28 to 23 or down -18%; median DOM was 11 days, -1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of April was up 13% over March, down -34% from April of last year
- Closed sales decreased -11% from March from 254 to 225, Closed sales down -50% from April 2022

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,768,000 and sold in 8 days for 105% of the list price based on 581 sales in April 2023

- Inventory was 669 up 9% from March 2023 and down -19% from April 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -6 days from 24 to 18 or -25%; median DOM decreased -1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of April was up 1% over March, and down -37% from April of last year
- Closed sales were down -10% from March from 643 to 581, Closed sales down -45% from April 2022

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,349,500 and sold in 16 days for 100% of the list price based on 76 sales in April 2023

- Inventory was 239 up 21% from March and up 20% from April 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -9 days from 47 to 38 days or down -19%; median DOM increased by 3 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of April was up 16% from March, down -27% from April of last year
- Closed sales were down -22% from March from 98 to 76, Closed sales down -58% from April 2022

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$900,000 and sold in 17 days for 99% of the list price based on 128 sales in April 2023

- Inventory was 315 down -2% from March 2023 and down -8% from April 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -11 days from 45 to 34 or down -24%; median DOM increased 2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of April was down -2% from March, and down -41% from April of last year
- Closed sales decreased -18% from March from 157 to 128, Closed sales were down -28% from April 2022

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$792,500 and sold in 29 days for 99% of the list price based on 32 sales in April 2023

- Inventory was 85 down -7% from March 2022 and down -17% from April 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) increased by 4 days from 53 to 57 or up 8%; median DOM decreased -1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of April was down -7% over March, and down -57% from April of last year
- Closed sales decreased -11% from March from 36 to 32, Closed sales down -40% from April 2022
