Single Family Homes August 2023

In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,800,000 and sold in 12 days for 103% of the list price based on 317 sales in August 2023

- Inventory was 422 down -1% from July and down -21% from August 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) increased 8 days from 20 to 28 or up 40%; median DOM was 12 days, 1 day more than the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of August was up 18% over July, down
  -1% from August of last year
- Closed sales increased 14% from July from 278 to 317, Closed sales down -7% from August 2022

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,826,500 and sold in 8 days for 105% of the list price based on 688 sales in August 2023

- Inventory was 654 up 7% from July 2023 and down -41% from August 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) increased 1 day from 16 to 17 or up 6%; median DOM was unchanged from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of August was up 22% over July, and down
  -4% from August of last year
- Closed sales were up 12% from July from 612 to 688, Closed sales down -14% from August 2022

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,200,000 and sold in 15 days for 100% of the list price based on 125 sales in August 2023

- Inventory was 291 down -1% from July and up 2% from August 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -5 days from 33 to 28 days or down -15%; median DOM (15 days) was an increase of 1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of August was up 15% from July, and up 3% from August of last year
- Closed sales were unchanged from July at 125, Closed sales were down -14% from August 2022

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$889,000 and sold in 13 days for 100% of the list price based on 171 sales in August 2023

- Inventory was 392 up 1% from July 2023 and down -23% from August 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) increased by 1 day from 35 to 36 or up 3%; median DOM increased 1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of August was up 17% from July, and down
  -15% from August of last year
- Closed sales increased 20% from July from 142 to 171, Closed sales were down
  -5% from August 2022

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$815,437 and sold in 35 days for 100% of the list price based on 47 sales in August 2023

- Inventory was 111 down -5% from July 2022 and down -28% from August 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -2 days from 44 to 42 or down -5%; median DOM increased 12 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of August was up 10% over July, and down -10% from August of last year
- Closed sales increased 42% from July from 33 to 47, Closed sales were up 81% from August 2022

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
