



MLSListings County Summaries Single Family Homes | February 2023

In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,950,000 and sold in 12 days for 100% of the list price based on 177 sales in February 2023

- Inventory was 310 down -2% from January and up 5% from February 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) moved down -7 days from 39 to 32 or down -18%; median DOM decreased by -17 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was up 14% over January, down -39% from February of last year
- Closed sales increased 11% from January from 160 to 177, Closed sales down -20% from February 2022

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,480,000 and sold in 10 days for 101% of the list price based on 353 sales in February 2023

- Inventory was 588 up 3% from January 2022 and up 18% from February 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -2 days from 35 to 33 or -6%; median DOM decreased -12 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was up 28% over January, and down -38% from February of last year
- Closed sales were up 18% from January from 299 to 353, Closed sales down -34% from February 2022

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,208,000 and sold in 24 days for 99% of the list price based on 58 sales in February 2023

- Inventory was 182 up 6% from January and up 17% from February 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -6 days from 54 to 48 days or down -11%; median DOM decreased by -11 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was up 102% from January, down -36% from February of last year
- Closed sales were down -6% from January from 62 to 58, Closed sales down -37% from February 2022





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In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$780,000 and sold in 22 days for 99% of the list price based on 101 sales in February 2023

- Inventory was 335 down -4% from January 2023 and up 21% from February 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -7 days from 52 to 45 or down -13%; median DOM decreased -14 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was up 19% over January, and down -27% from February of last year
- Closed sales were up 2% from January from 98 to 101, Closed sales were down -38% from February 2022

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$750,000 and sold in 42 days for 97% of the list price based on 31 sales in February 2023

- Inventory was 105 unchanged from January 2022 and up 38% from February 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) increased 13 days from 42 to 55 or up 31%; median DOM increased 13 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was down -22% over January, and down -37% from February of last year
- Closed sales were up 41% from January from 22 to 31, Closed sales down -26% from February 2022
