



MLSListings County Summaries Single Family Homes | June 2023

In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,950,000 and sold in 10 days for 103% of the list price based on 370 sales in June 2023

- Inventory was 430 up 2% from May and down -28% from June 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) gained 1 day from 19 to 20 or up 5%; median DOM was 10 days, 1 day more than the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -6% over May, down -27% from June of last year
- Closed sales increased 9% from May from 340 to 370, Closed sales down -1% from June 2022

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,804,000 and sold in 8 days for 105% of the list price based on 796 sales in June 2023

- Inventory was 600 down -12% from May 2023 and down -53% from June 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -2 days from 18 to 16 or -11%; median DOM was unchanged from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -19% over May, and down -35% from June of last year
- Closed sales were down -3% from May from 822 to 796, Closed sales down -14% from June 2022

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,200,000 and sold in 11 days for 102% of the list price based on 150 sales in June 2023

- Inventory was 301 up 8% from May and up 5% from June 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -9 days from 34 to 25 days or down -26%; median DOM (11 days) was unchanged from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -2% from May, but up 4% from June of last year
- Closed sales were up 20% from May from 125 to 150, Closed sales were up 5% from June 2022

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$800,000 and sold in 11 days for 100% of the list price based on 163 sales in June 2023

- Inventory was 370 up 8% from May 2023 and down -21% from June 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -8 days from 37 to 29 or down -22%; median DOM increased 1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was up 3% from May, and down -20% from June of last year
- Closed sales increased 3% from May from 159 to 163, Closed sales were down -24% from June 2022

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$757,073 and sold in 14 days for 100% of the list price based on 48 sales in June 2023

- Inventory was 104 up 4% from May 2022 and down -17% from June 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) increased by 11 days from 32 to 43 or up 34%; median DOM decreased -4 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -13% over May, and unchanged from June of last year
- Closed sales increased 12% from May from 42 to 48, Closed sales were up 12% from June 2022
