



MLSListings County Summaries Single Family Homes | May 2023

In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,900,000 and sold in 9 days for 104% of the list price based on 339 sales in May 2023

- Inventory was 421 up 7% from April and down -4% from May 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) moved down -4 days from 23 to 19 or down -17%; median DOM was 9 days, -2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of May was up 10% over April, down -19% from May of last year
- Closed sales increased 45% from April from 234 to 339, Closed sales down -28% from May 2022

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,757,500 and sold in 8 days for 105% of the list price based on 822 sales in May 2023

- Inventory was 674 unchanged from April 2023 and down -38% from May 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -1 day from 19 to 18 or -5%; median DOM was unchanged from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of May was up 13% over April, and down -30% from May of last year
- Closed sales were up 40% from April from 586 to 822, Closed sales down -15% from May 2022

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,352,000 and sold in 11 days for 100% of the list price based on 123 sales in May 2023

- Inventory was 281 up 17% from April and up 5% from May 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -4 days from 38 to 34 days or down -11%; median DOM decreased by -5 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of May was up 30% from April, down -14% from May of last year
- Closed sales were up 62% from April from 76 to 123, Closed sales were down -22% from May 2022

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$870,368 and sold in 10 days for 99% of the list price based on 158 sales in May 2023

- Inventory was 341 up 7% from April 2023 and down -20% from May 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) increased by 4 days from 33 to 37 or up 12%; median DOM decreased -7 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of May was up 29% from April, and down -36% from May of last year
- Closed sales increased 21% from April from 131 to 158, Closed sales were down -21% from May 2022

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$752,000 and sold in 18 days for 100% of the list price based on 42 sales in May 2023

- Inventory was 99 up 13% from April 2022 and down -15% from May 2022
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -25 days from 57 to 32 or down -44%; median DOM decreased -11 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of May was up 76% over April, and down -7% from May of last year
- Closed sales increased 31% from April from 32 to 42, Closed sales down -26% from May 2022
