- Number of new listings for the month of October was down -17% from September, and up 11% from October of last year
- Closed sales were up 4% from September at 112, Closed sales were up 11% from October 2022

- Inventory was 348 down -7% from September 2023 and down -22% from October 2022

- Number of new listings for the month of October was down -4% from September, and up 6% from October of last year
- Closed sales decreased -6% from September from 155 to 146, Closed sales were down -3% from October 2022

- Closed sales decreased -22% from September from 41 to 32, Closed sales were down -20% from October 2022
