In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,884,444 and sold in 10 days for 105% of the list price based on 208 sales in February 2024

- Inventory was 295 up 2% from January and down -7% from February 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased 14 days from 41 to 27 or down -34%; median DOM was 10 days, a decrease of 10 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was up 7% over January, up 17% from February of last year
- Closed sales increased 45% from January from 143 to 208, Closed sales up 16% from February 2023

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,800,000 and sold in 8 days for 107% of the list price based on 447 sales in February 2024

- Closed sales were up 25% from January from 358 to 447, Closed sales were up 25% from February 2023

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,215,000 and sold in 15 days for 101% of the list price based on 67 sales in February 2024

- Inventory was 183 up 2% from January and up 1% from February 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -2 days from 47 to 45 days or down -4%; median DOM (15 days) saw a decrease of -25 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was up 17% from January, and up 9% from February of last year
- Closed sales were up 16% from January from 58 to 67, Closed sales were up 16% from February 2023

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$853,000 and sold in 19 days for 100% of the list price based on 102 sales in February 2024

- Inventory was 334 up 3% from January and down -1% from February 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -5 days from 46 to 41 or down -11%; median DOM decreased -7 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was up 11% from January, and down -4% from February of last year
- Closed sales increased 6% from January from 96 to 102, Closed sales were unchanged from February 2023

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$780,000 and sold in 39 days for 99% of the list price based on 35 sales in February 2024

- Inventory was 95 up 8% from January and down -10% from February 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased by -30 days from 70 to 40 or down -43%; median DOM decreased -15 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of February was up 9% over January, and up 24% from February of last year
- Closed sales were up 6% from January at 35, Closed sales were up 13% from February 2023

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
