## Common Interest Homes June 2024

In San Mateo County, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$1,000,000 and sold in 14 days for 101% of the list price based on 97 sales in June 2024

- Inventory was 251 up 7% from May and up 51% from June 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 6 days from 24 to 30 or up 25%; median DOM increased by 3 days from the prior month.
- Number of new listings for the month of June were down -18% over May, and up 12% from June of last year
- Closed sales were down -17% from May from 117 to 97, closed sales were down -16% from June 2023

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$1,075,000 and sold in 10 days for 104% of the list price based on 343 sales in June 2024

- Inventory was 550 up 8% from May and up 97% from June 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 3 days from 15 to 18 or up 20%; median DOM increased 1 day from the prior month.
- Number of new listings for the month of June were down -21% compared to May, and up 25% from June of last year.
- Closed sales were down -16% from May from 406 to 343, closed sales were up 8% from June 2023.

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$865,000 and sold in 13 days for 100% of the list price based on 26 sales in June 2024

- Inventory was 86 up 16% from May and up 83% from June 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -7 days from 28 to 21 or down -25%; median DOM dropped -2 days from the prior month.
- Number of new listings for the month of June were up 11% over May, and up 63% from June of last year
- Closed sales were down -32% from May from 38 to 26, closed sales were down -7% from June 2023

In **Monterey County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$845,000 and sold in 32 days for 98% of the list price based on 22 sales in June 2024

- Inventory was 72, up 7% from May and up 76% from June 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) increased by 17 days from 35 to 52 days or up 49%; median DOM increased 18 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June were up 3% over May, and up 40% from June of last year
- Closed sales decreased -29% from May from 31 to 22, and were down 24% from June 2023

In San Benito County, there were no Residential - Common Interest home sales in June 2024

- Inventory was 13, down -7% from May and up 117% from June 2023
- Number of new listings for the month of June were down -80% over May and down -50% from June of last year
