Single Family Homes September 2024

In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,950,000 and sold in 13 days for 105% of the list price based on 327 sales in September 2024

- Inventory was 521 up 12% from August and down -3% from September 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) was unchanged at 24 days; median DOM was 13 days, unchanged from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of September were up 9% over August, and down
 10% from September of last year
- Closed sales decreased -2% from August from 333 to 327, Closed sales were up 6% from September 2023

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,900,000 and sold in 10 days for 105% of the list price based on 635 sales in September 2024

- Inventory was 908 up 14% from August and up 26% from September 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) increased 3 days from 18 to 21 or up 17%; median DOM was unchanged at 10 days.
- Number of new listings for the month of September was up 13% over August, and up 21% from September of last year
- Closed sales were down -17% from August from 761 to 635, and up 5% from September 2023

In Santa Cruz County, the median Single Family home cost \$1,285,000 and sold in 21 days for 100% of the list price based on 99 sales in September 2024

- Inventory was 385 up 8% from August and up 30% from September 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 10 days from 30 to 40 days or up 33%; median DOM (21 days) saw an increase of 5 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of September was down -7% from August, and up 2% from September of last year
- Closed sales were down -26% from August from 134 to 99, and down -8% from September 2023

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,000,000 and sold in 17 days for 99% of the list price based on 150 sales in September 2024

- Inventory was 530 unchanged from August and up 41% from September 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 1 day from 36 to 37 days or up 3%; median DOM decreased -1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of September was down -20% from August, and up 11% from September of last year
- Closed sales increased 3% from August from 146 to 150, closed sales decreased -3% from September 2023

In San Benito County, the median Single Family home cost \$833,255 and sold in 36 days for 100% of the list price based on 47 sales in September 2024

- Inventory was 128 up 8% from August and up 5% from September 2023
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 15 days from 35 to 50 or up 43%; median DOM increased 4 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of September was down -11% over August, and down -25% from September of last year
- Closed sales were up 31% from August from 36 to 47, Closed sales were up 15% from September 2023
