- Closed sales were up 8% from May from 766 to 830 and up 2% from June 2024

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,335,000 and sold in 15 days for 99% of the list price based on 130 sales in June 2025

- Inventory was 532 up 1% from May and up 51% from June 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 1 day from 25 to 26 days or up 4%; median DOM increased 2 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was down -26% from May, and up 24% from June of last year
- Closed sales were up 4% from May from 125 to 130, and up 15% from June 2024

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$962,000 and sold in 21 days for 99% of the list price based on 152 sales in June 2025

- Inventory was 565 up 3% from May and up 14% from June 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) increased 11 days from 37 to 48 days or up 30%; median DOM increased 3 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June were down -11% from May, and down -6% from June of last year
- Closed sales increased 10% from May from 138 to 152, closed sales increased 17% from June 2024

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$876,444 and sold in 24 days for 100% of the list price based on 41 sales in June 2025

- Inventory was 152 up 5% from May and up 11% from June 2024.
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -4 days from 42 to 38 or down -10%; median DOM decreased -14 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of June was up 3% over May, and up 16% from June of last year.
- Closed sales were up 21% from May from 34 to 41, Closed sales were up 32% from June 2024.
