- Number of new listings for the month of May was up 21% from April, and up 30% from May of last year
- Closed sales were down -5% from April from 131 to 125, and up 13% from May 2024

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$897,000 and sold in 17 days for 99% of the list price based on 137 sales in May 2025

- Inventory was 545 up 9% from April and up 22% from May 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased -2 days from 39 to 37 days or down -5%; median DOM increased 3 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of May were down -10% from April, and down -3% from May of last year
- Closed sales decreased -22% from April from 175 to 137, closed sales decreased -22% from May 2024

- Inventory was 146 up 13% from April and up 17% from May 2024.

- Closed sales were down -33% from April from 46 to 31, Closed sales were down -28% from May 2024.
