In **San Mateo County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$912,500 and sold in 24 days for 100% of the list price based on 102 sales in May 2025

- Inventory was 348 up 3% from April and up 43% from May 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 7 days from 32 to 39 or up 22%; median DOM increased 11 days from the prior month.
- Number of new listings for the month of May were down -29% over April, and was down -12% from May of last year
- Closed sales were down -19% from April from 126 to 102, closed sales were down -13% from May 2024

- Inventory was 874 up 3% from April and up 58% from May 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 4 days from 20 to 24 or up 20%; median DOM moved up 6 days from the prior month.
- Number of new listings for the month of May were down -13% compared to April, and down -7% from May of last year.
- Closed sales were down -12% from April from 330 to 292, closed sales were down -28% from May 2024.

In **Santa Cruz County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$781,000 and sold in 32 days for 98% of the list price based on 34 sales in May 2025

- Inventory was 150 up 5% from April and up 88% from May 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) moved 26 days from 30 to 56 or up 87%; median DOM increased 23 days from the prior month.
- Number of new listings for the month of May were down -21% over April, and up 22% from May of last year
- Closed sales were up 36% from April from 25 to 34, closed sales were down -11% from May 2024

In **Monterey County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$677,500 and sold in 24 days for 98% of the list price based on 14 sales in May 2025

- Inventory was 92, up 11% from April and up 37% from May 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) increased by 14 days from 49 to 63 days or up 29%; median DOM decreased by -4 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings was down -17% for the month of May, and down -15% from May of last year.
- Closed sales decreased -44% from April from 25 to 15 and were down -55% from May 2024.

In **San Benito County**, the median Residential - Common Interest home cost \$629,900 and sold in 13 days for 100% of the list price based on 3 sales in May 2025.

- Inventory was 7, down -36% from April and down -56% from May 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) was 9 days; median DOM was 13 days.
- Number of new listings was down -83% from April, and down -90% from May of last year.
- Closed sales were up 50% from April from 2 to 3, Closed sales were up 200% from May 2024.

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
