In **San Mateo County**, the median Single Family home cost \$2,000,000 and sold in 12 days for 105% of the list price based on 412 sales in October 2025

- Inventory was 517 down -10% from September and up 9% from October 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -4 days from 30 to 26 or down -13%; median DOM decreased -1 day from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October were down -14% over September, and up 14% from October of last year
- Closed sales were up 13% from September from 365 to 412, Closed sales were up 13% from October 2024

In **Santa Clara County**, the median Single Family home cost \$1,910,000 and sold in 11 days for 104% of the list price based on 759 sales in October 2025

- Inventory was 890 down -12% from September and up 6% from October 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) decreased -1 day from 25 to 24 or down -4%; median DOM was 11 days, unchanged from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October was down -21% over September, and down -9% from October of last year
- Closed sales were up 7% from September from 708 to 759 and down -1% from October 2024

In Santa Cruz County, the median Single Family home cost \$1,277,911 and sold in 26 days for 99% of the list price based on 124 sales in October 2025

- Inventory was 455 down -5% from September and up 10% from October 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -5 days from 47 to 42 days or down -11%; median DOM decreased -3 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October was down -20% from September, and down -20% from October of last year
- Closed sales were down -6% from September from 132 to 124, and down -8% from October 2024

In **Monterey County**, the median Single Family home cost \$993,000 and sold in 32 days for 97% of the list price based on 181 sales in October 2025

- Inventory was 547 down -10% from September and up 6% from October 2024
- Average days on market (DOM) increased 6 days from 50 to 56 days or up 12%; median DOM increased 14 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October were down -19% from September, and down -8% from October of last year
- Closed sales increased 26% from September from 144 to 181, closed sales increased 27% from October 2024

In **San Benito County**, the median Single Family home cost \$744,821 and sold in 27 days for 100% of the list price based on 33 sales in October 2025

- Inventory was 142 down -10% from September and up 17% from October 2024.
- Average days on market (DOM) moved -17 days from 57 to 40 or down -30%; median DOM decreased -10 days from the month before.
- Number of new listings for the month of October was down -11% over September, and up 6% from October of last year.
- Closed sales were down -11% from September from 37 to 33, Closed sales were down -13% from October 2024.

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
